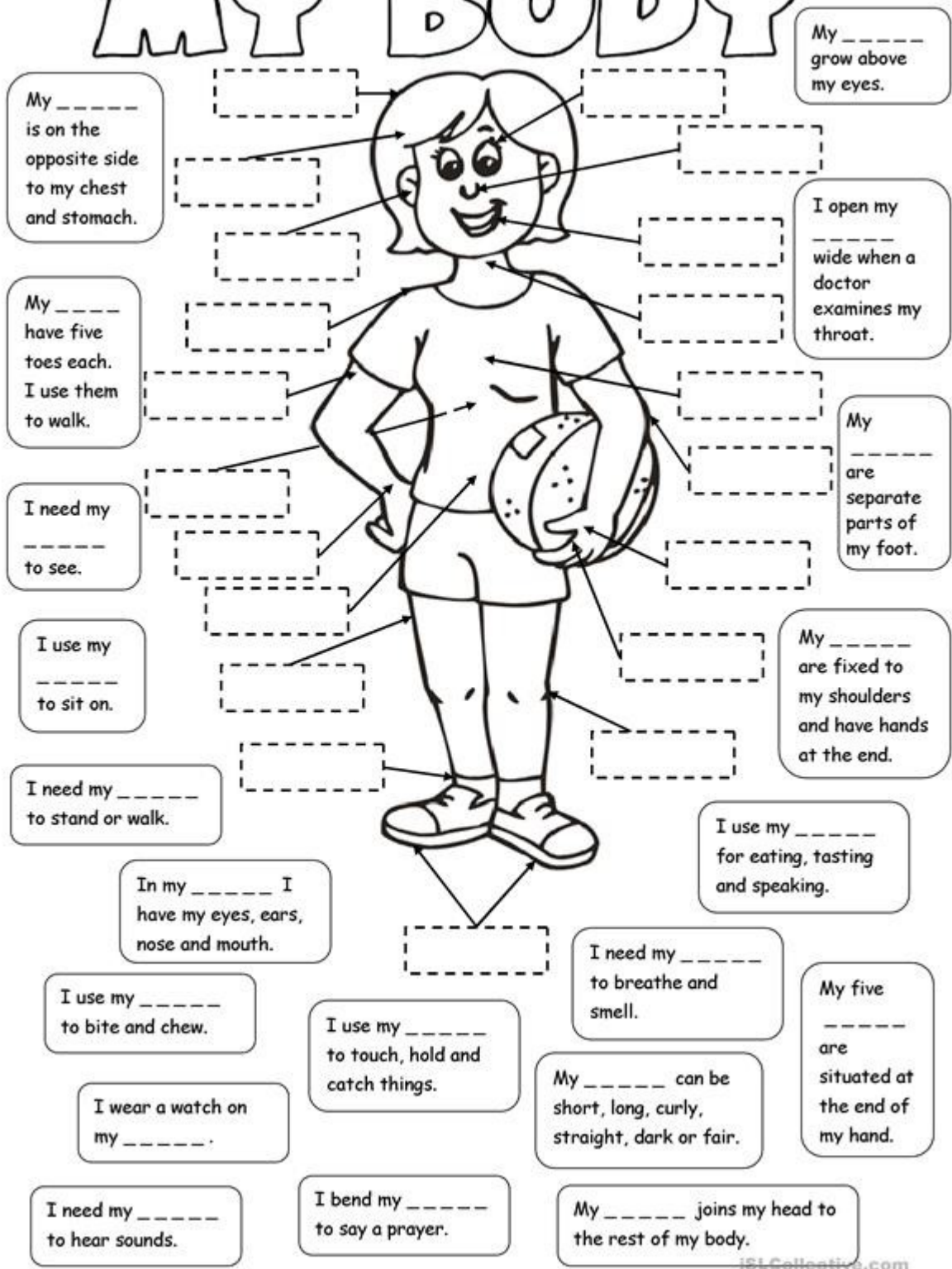


# MY BODY
